Tough, fire-resistant cotton and job-proven designs keep protection in place without getting in the way of your work.

The range includes an **FR Helmet Liner**, **FR Winter Balaclava**, and **FR Welder's Cap**, so you can match your protection to the conditions on the floor. The helmet liner delivers lightweight, all-around coverage with a contoured fit and circular neck drape that shields the sides of the face, neck, and shoulders. When the temperature drops, the winter balaclava steps in with added warmth from a micro-fleece lining, flat-seam construction to reduce irritation, and EN ISO 11611 certification for welding protection. For everyday jobs, the welder's cap offers a secure, stay-put fit with stretch side panels, ear coverage, and an extended rear panel designed to keep sparks and slag off the back of your neck. Built tough, comfortable enough for all-day wear, and ready for real shop conditions—this FR headwear lineup helps you stay focused on the weld, not the heat.

Intended Use:

Class 2 - Recommended for manual welding techniques with heavy formation of spatters and drops e.g MMA welding (with basic or cellulose-covered electrode), MAG welding (CO₂ or mixed gases), MIG welding (with high current), self-shielded flux cored arc welding, plasma cutting, gouging, oxygen cutting, thermal spraying for operation of machines e.g. in confined spaces, at overhead welding/cutting or in constrained positions. This clothing is intended to protect against flames, molten metal, spatter, radiant heat and short term, accidental electrical contact.

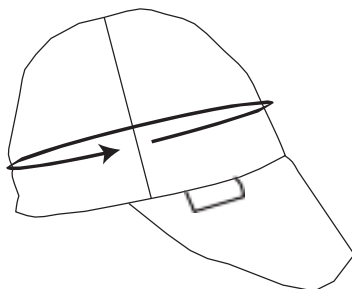
